Dear Friends,

It is with immense joy and a profound sense of hope that I congratulate His Holiness, Pope Leo XIV, as the 267th Bishop of Rome and successor to Saint Peter.

Born in Chicago, USA, in 1955, Pope Leo XIV was ordained a priest of the Order of Saint Augustine (O.S.A.) in 1981. Since then, he has served in various roles, including Bishop of Chiclayo, Peru, from 2015 to 2023.
