

## **Pre-Kindergarten Supply List 2023 - 2024**

**Below is the list of materials that each student must bring to school for September.  
Please ensure you LABEL ALL CLOTHING.**

**DO NOT LABEL school supplies with your child's name, as these become shared supplies.**

- One pair of running shoes that your child can **easily** put on and take off (please do not send runners with laces unless your child has been taught to tie their own laces.) No black soles please.
  - An 'Arts & Crafts' fee of \$25.00
  - 1 package of computer paper
  - 4 x 20g **Elmer's "Disappearing Purple"** glue sticks.
  - 2 x 24 count Crayola crayons
  - 2 x 4 pack sleeves of Play Dough (**448g/16oz**)
  - 4 boxes of Kleenex
  - 2 containers of disinfectant wipes (Lysol)
  - 2 bottles of hand sanitizer
  - A bag with change of clothes to remain at school (pair of underwear, socks, shirt, and pants)
  - A water bottle for daily use (child size, plastic and spill proof)
  - A lunch kit – please send forks and spoons in lunch kit daily if needed. **NO GLASS FOOD CONTAINERS PLEASE**
  - A backpack to be brought to school every day for notes and work

- We promote nutritious morning snacks, lunches and afternoon snacks (**please do not send candy, chocolate or potato chips**).
  - We do not have a place to heat up food for Pre-K, so please ensure a thermos is used to keep food warm.
  - If you send your child with a thermos (noodles, rice, other). Please send a plastic bowl that the food can be transferred into. We have found this way to be kid friendly manageable.
  - For your child's safety. Please cut up all foods into child bite size pieces. Do not send meat on bones as they are a choking risk.
